#### Uninsured Tennesseans

16% of Tennesseans aged 18-64 are uninsured! Expanding Medicaid could extend coverage to 151,000 additional residents and reduce the Tennessee's uninsured rate by 27%.2

#### **Hospital Closures**

In states that have expanded Medicaid, rural hospitals are 62 percent less likely to face closure. While rural areas have fewer providers, physicians in these areas are more inclined to accept new Medicaid patients compared to their urban counterparts.4

#### Medical Debt.

Tennessee counties with higher rates of medical debt are more likely to have elevated rates of uninsured residents. People with medical debt are less likely to access needed medical care and more likely to have poor health outcomes.



#### Missed Federal Economic Benefits

Expansion states gain access to federally matched funds for traditional Medicaid coverage and support from the American Rescue Plan (ARP). Between 2022 and 2025, states that expand Medicaid stand to receive \$90 billion in federal funds and an estimated \$6.6 billion boost in state and local tax revenue.

#### Worse Health Outcomes

Mortality rates in rural areas are higher than those in urban areas across the top five causes of death. Medicaid expansion has been linked to a 3.6 percent reduction in mortality rates among adults aged 20 to 64.












